PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO ADDC BYLAWS

Received From Regional Director Keith Atkins Tuesday, March 9, 2010

Dues and Fees, Section 1
And
Amendment #2
Standing Rule 8 To Two Sections:
A. Fund Raising
And
B. Promotional/Gift Items

The above two proposed amendments will be part of the business at the 2010 ADDC Convention in Houston in September. They will be discussed at the Open Forum during the Region III Meeting in Houma April 2010.

Proposed Amendment Number 1

Amend Article VII – Dues and Fees, Section 1. (a) by striking the words "Thirty-Five Dollars (\$35.00)" between the words "be" and "in" and inserting the words "Forty-Five Dollars (\$45.00)".

Now Reads:

Annual dues payable to the Association by each club shall be <u>Thirty-Five Dollars</u> (\$35.00) in U.S. funds for each member of such club.

Amend to Read:

Annual dues payable to the Association by each club shall be <u>Forty-Five Dollars (\$45.00)</u> in U.S. funds for each member of such club.

Rationale:

The current dues do not cover the Association's annual operating expenses. The 2010 board had to approve an "unbalanced" budget (expenses exceeded revenue). The 2009 board had the same issue. Both boards diligently tried to cut expenses without reducing membership benefits. Over the past several years, we have become very dependent upon the sale of the Energy Activity Books and will continue to consider these sales as part of our revenue but these sales will only cover so much of the expenses. The 2010 board also took into consideration that there has not been a dues increase since 2005 (approved in 2004). As we all are aware expenses such as travel have increased since 2005.

Comments For:

The Association budget is really lean and there are only so many places that can be trimmed back and still be able to operate efficiently.

The cost of running the Association has gone up just like everyone else's costs. This is a small increase, less that \$1.00 a month, and still the Association dues would be less than \$50 a year. Compared to dues for other organizations this is a bargain.

We understand that our members and, in most cases, their employers as financial sponsors, have been hit by the current economic shifts. Our members should be equally aware that those same economic shifts which we've all faced in our personal and business lives have also affected ADDC. If you compare the rate at which our dues have risen

over the years in relation to the rate the cost of living has increased, you will recognize the hard work your Boards have done throughout the years to deliver quality services for minimum expenses.

The Association needs the increase in dues to continue providing the level of service and commitment to our educational purpose that we do now. At \$45 our dues will still be below other industry organizations.

I think it's time to raise the dues. We are one of the cheapest organizations that I know. In order to provide all that we do, the increase in dues is needed.

Expenses for everyone have increased over the past five years. It makes good fiscal sense to increase our annual dues.

I agree, but am concerned over whether or not some of the smaller clubs will be able to handle the increase.

Expenses have increased over the past five years — makes sense to increase annual dues payable to the Association for each club.

Our club charges \$40 for membership. We give \$35 to the Association, we send \$2 to our region fund and keep \$3 for our local club. We see no problem with the increase. Ten dollars is not that much money. A person could save \$1 a month to pay for this.

Comments Against:

With company support less common, I believe the \$10 increase is too much. I would be more comfortable with a \$5 increase. I am concerned about losing the smaller clubs with the increase.

I believe that a \$10.00 increase is not justified at this time. Many of our club members also are having to chinch their belts in this down economy and would have a difficult time with the increase that large. But I would favor an increase of \$5 at this time.

Proposed Amendment Number 2

Amend Standing Rule 8 to two sections: A. Fund Raising and B. Promotional/Gift Items.

Now Reads:

Fund raising is permissible where necessary to further the educational purposes of our organization. Proper records and reporting must be maintained and filed in accordance with the tax-exempt status of the Association and clubs. The Association guidelines must be followed for fund-raising projects. Specific, but not all-inclusive, requirements include:

- a. Any club contemplating a fund-raising project should ensure that such project is in the best interest of the Association and will not injure the image and dignity of Desk and Derrick.
- b. Any club sales item and accompanying printed materials bearing the words "Desk and Derrick," "D&D," "Association of Desk and Derrick Clubs," "ADDC," and/or the trademark (insignia) must receive Association Board approval by application through regional directors.
- c. Approval for any sales item not bearing the words and/or trademark (insignia) outlined in item b (above) shall be obtained:
 - 1. Club or regional items sold within that region require approval by that regional director only.
 - 2. Club or regional items sold in other regions must receive Association Board approval by application through the regional director.
- d. Lotteries and raffles that are prohibited by local or post office regulations are not to be conducted.

Amend to Read:

A. Fund Raising

Fund raising is permissible where necessary to further the educational purposes of our organization. Proper records and reporting must be maintained and filed in accordance with the tax-exempt status of the Association and clubs. The Association guidelines must be followed for fund-raising projects. Specific, but not all-inclusive, requirements include:

- a. Any club contemplating a fund-raising project should ensure that such project is in the best interest of the Association and will not injure the image and dignity of Desk and Derrick.
- b. Any club sales item and accompanying printed materials bearing the words "Desk and Derrick," "D&D," "Association of Desk and Derrick Clubs," "ADDC," and/or the trademark (insignia) must receive Association Board approval by application through regional directors.
- c. Approval for any sales item not bearing the words and/or trademark (insignia) outlined in Item b (above) shall be obtained:

- 1. Club or regional items sold within that region require approval by that regional director only.
- 2. Club or regional items sold in other regions must receive Association Board approval by application through the regional director.
- d. Lotteries and raffles that are prohibited by local or post office regulations are not to be conducted.

B: Promotional and Gift Items

The Association guidelines must be followed for all promotional and gift items bearing the ADDC logo or ADDC name in any manner. Specific, but not all-inclusive, requirements include:

- a. Any club contemplating a promotional or gift item should ensure that such project is in the best interest of the Association and will not injure the image and dignity of Desk and Derrick.
- b. Any such item and accompanying printed materials bearing the words "Desk and Derrick," "D&D," "Association of Desk and Derrick Clubs," "ADDC," and/or the trademark (insignia) must receive Association Board approval by application through regional directors.

Rational:

Standing Rule 8 covers the use of the logo and Desk and Derrick name for fund raising, but does not cover the NON-sale items like glassware, shirts, paperweights, and other such items given away or distributed at the regional meetings. This is a provision to control the use of the logo and name on ALL items that are created for distribution within clubs and/or at regional meetings, convention, trade shows, etc. because numerous items given away or sold at club level have misused the name, using Desk & Derrick, for example, or Association of Desk & Derrick – without Clubs – on items given to club members or regional meeting attendees over the years.
