As we look back in history, we remember San Antonio's early contributions to the Oil and Gas industry.

George Dullnig's discovery (1886):

San Antonio rancher George <u>Dullnig</u>, was drilling for water on his Bexar County property and instead hit oil and gas. This was the first recorded production of both oil and gas in Texas, predating the larger, more famous discoveries.

More modern innovations:

A company headquartered in San Antonio, <u>BlackBrush</u> Oil & Gas has pioneered advancements in horizontal drilling. They were the first company to successfully drill and exploit the horizontal San Miguel formation and have also led in drilling numerous horizontal Buda wells.


